Textile Industry of India

- India has a 4% share of the global trade in textiles and apparel
- India is the world's largest producer of cotton
- India is also the 2nd largest producer of silk in the world
- Production of fibre in India reached 2.40 MT in FY21 (till January 2021), while for yarn, the production stood at 4,762 million kgs during the same period.
- India's textile and apparel exports (including handicrafts) stood at US\$ 44.4 billion in FY22
- India's textile industry is the biggest employer after agriculture in the country, employing around 45 million people and 100 million people in allied industries
- The powerloom sector of India is producing all kinds of fabrics and made ups such as fabrics for shirts, suiting, denim, ladies dress material, shawls, technical textiles etc. in any fibre quality viz; cotton, viscose, polyester, silk, wool, nylon etc.
- About 25 lakh powerlooms are there in India spread all across the country with some important clusters such as, Bhivandi, Ichalkaranji, Solapur, Erode, Coimbatore, Salem, Tirupur, Karur, Ahmedabad, Surat, etc.
